It's just about tomato time again people... and these two recipes might help your crop along a bit:

Homemade Monster Tomato Fertilizer Recipe

2-3 Dozen crushed egg shells (calcium)
2 Cups Blood and Bone
1/2 Cup Epsom Salts
14 Crushed Asprin (a natural rooting hormone)

Mix together then put 1/4 of cup in each hole. Stake your plant, mulch, then every 6 weeks add 1 hand full of mix around plant.

A Simple Fertilizer From The Greek Gods:

2 Tablespoons of Flat Beer
2 Tablespoons Honey
2 Tablespoons Whole Milk
4 1/2 Lt Rain Water

Mix together, then leave overnight. Stir gently, then spray garden, before planting spray again. Also good to spray compost heap every six months. Microorganisms love this mix.

Artichoke, Asparagus, Beetroot, Burdock., Cabbage, Carrots, Celery, Endive, Leek, Lettuce, Mustard, Onion, Parsnip, Peas, Radish, Rocket, Silver beet, Turnip,

HERBS

Basil, Borage, Burnet, Caraway, camomile, chervil, coriander, Cress, Dill, Echinacea, Lemon Balm, Lavage, Marjoram, Mint Nasturtium, Oregano, Parsley, Rosemary, Rue, Sage, Savoury, Thyme, Wormwood, Yarrow.

FLOWERS

Alyssum, Amaranth, Aquilegia, Aster, Brachycome, Calendula, Candy Tuff, Carnation, Cosmos, Dahlia, Dianthus, Four O'clock, Godetia, Honesty, Impatience, Larks Spur, Lavender, Lunarian, Livingston Daisy, Lobelia, Marigold, Nigella, Pansy, Petunia, Phlox, Snap Dragon, Stat ice, Sun Flower, Sweet Pea, Viola, Zinnia

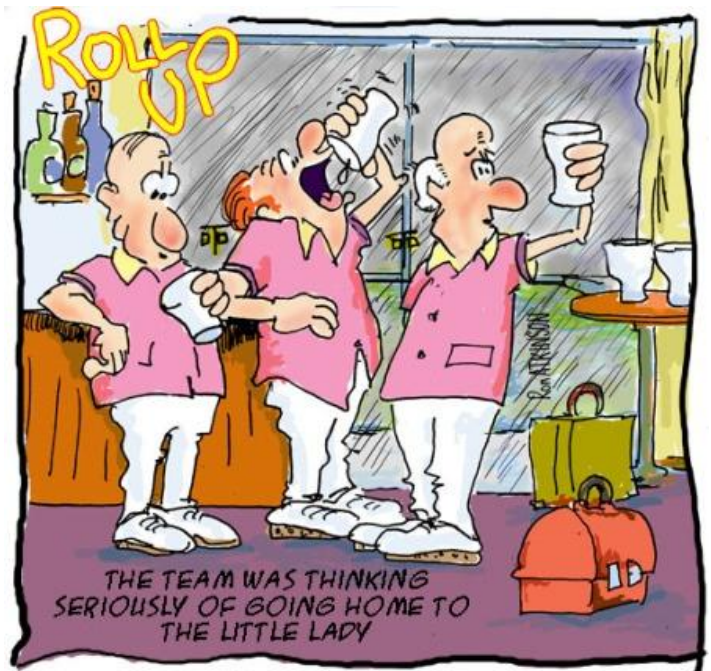

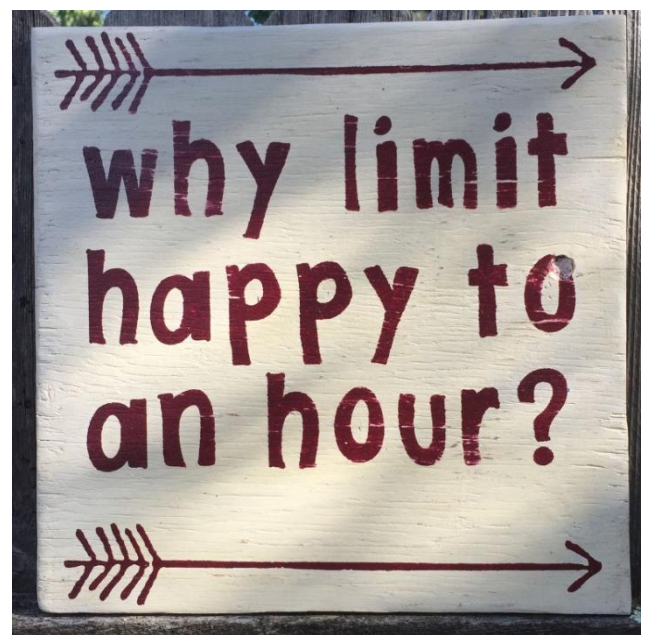
